



VALORSCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The University of Silicon Valley Valor Scholarship Program is a need-based scholarship program that is designed to provide tuition assistance to eligible students with demonstrated financial need. Financial need is based upon the difference between available resources and funding eligibility relative to the direct educational program costs. This scholarship program is designed to help students who meet the criteria outlined below. The criteria have been designed to give the Scholarship Selection Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. Applicants will be selected without regard to race, color, sex, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, disability, or any other legally protected status.

Eligibility Criteria:

This scholarship program is available to accepted applicants and currently enrolled and/or attending students who meet the admissions requirements for the University of Silicon Valley. Additionally, applicants must meet all of the stated criteria outlined below to be eligible to apply.

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- x Be a US citizen, eligible non-citizen, or DACA student;
- x Be accepted, enrolled, or attending the University of Silicon Valley
